### Directions to Lehigh Eye Specialists

- From the N.E. Extension of the PA Turnpike (Rt. 476): Rt 22 East to Rt. 309 South (I-78 East). Follow 309 South (I-78 East) to the Cedar Crest Blvd. exit. Turn right from exit. Turn left at the traffic light into the parking lot.
- From Route 309 North (I-78 West): Take the Cedar Crest Blvd. exit. Turn left from exit. Turn left at the second traffic light into the parking lot.
- From Route 22:

If coming from points west of the N.E. Extension of the PA Turnpike (Rt. 476): Take I-78 East (merges with Rt. 309 South) to the Cedar Crest Blvd. exit, then turn right from exit. Turn left at traffic light into the parking lot.

If coming from points east of the N.E. Extension of the PA Turnpike (Rt. 476): Take Rt. 309 South (merges with I-78 East) to the Cedar Crest Blvd. exit, then turn right from exit. Turn left at traffic light into the parking lot.

**Welcome** to Lehigh Eye Specialists. Our practice specializes in the medical and surgical care of ophthalmic diseases and abnormalities. With extensive experience in their respective areas of expertise, our fellowship-trained ophthalmologists are able to provide you with “one-stop” specialty ophthalmic care. Dr. Kazahaya is a Posterior Segment Specialist, providing care relating to the Retina and Vitreous. Dr. DeRose is an Anterior Segment Specialist, caring for problems relating to the Cornea, Glaucoma, Cataracts, and Refractive Surgery. Together, with our friendly and professional staff, we strive to offer you the highest quality, state-of-the-art eye care in a caring and compassionate environment.

**Posterior Segment** – Dr. Kazahaya specializes in the diseases and surgery of the retina and vitreous. Lehigh Eye Specialists has the region’s most modern and sophisticated diagnostic and therapeutic equipment, including scanning laser ophthalmoscope-based digital fluorescein angiography (FA) with eye-tracking capability, high-definition spectral-domain optical coherence tomography (HD-OCT), the PASCAL laser (for greater patient comfort), conventional lasers, high-definition ultrasonography, and cryotherapy. With our expertise and specialized equipment, we are able to provide you with the most advanced retinal care for diseases, such as diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration, retinal tears and detachments, macular holes, macular pucker, and posterior complications of cataract surgery.

**Anterior Segment** – Dr. DeRose specializes in the medical and surgical treatment of anterior segment abnormalities, including corneal edema and scarring, keratoconus, refractive abnormalities, glaucoma, dry eye syndrome, and complicated cataracts. He has extensive experience in the latest innovations in this complex specialty. Dr. DeRose performs penetrating keratoplasty, DSEK, LASIK, PRK, glaucoma surgery, small-incision phacoemulsification for cataract surgery, and surgery for anterior complications of cataract surgery. Using specialized equipment,

such as immersion biometry for lifestyle IOL’s, high-definition anterior segment OCT, corneal topography, and pachymetry, Dr. DeRose is able to provide his patients with the highest level of anterior segment care.

### **OFFICE VISITS**

Office visits are scheduled by appointment only. Please keep in mind that it takes approximately *one hour* for your complete eye examination, which usually includes taking a history, checking your vision and intraocular pressures, slit-lamp examination, and dilated fundus examination. Depending upon the nature of your problem, additional tests and/or procedures might be recommended. This could extend the duration of your visit. For your convenience most tests and procedures are performed in our office and often, on the same day as your visit. Although we make every attempt to remain on schedule, we are sometimes delayed due to emergencies. (We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.) Because your eyes will be dilated when you leave the office, we recommend that you have a driver. A report of your visit will be sent to your referring doctor.

Please be advised that as *specialists*, we do not perform routine/general eye examinations or prescribe glasses/contact lenses.

### **SURGERY**

Although many of our procedures can be performed in the office, some require an operating room. Most surgeries can be done on an outpatient basis. We perform our surgeries in some of the region’s most specialized facilities. Hospitalization after surgery may be necessary for certain special conditions and circumstances.
